<b>COMPANY FINANCIALS, ANNUAL REPORTS AND PEOPLE</b>	
<b>Amadeus</b> [BVD]	EUROPE: Contains financial data for both public and private companies in Europe.
<b>Bloomberg</b> [Bloomberg]	GLOBAL: Features company financials, market data spanning more than 20 years, charts, statistics, and current news reports.  🔑 <i>Use in Sainsbury Library only</i>
<b>Capital IQ</b> [S&P]	GLOBAL: Combines information on companies, markets, and people worldwide with tools for analysis.  🔑 <b>Requires individually assigned log-ins. Please use the “register via MySBS” link on the Sainsbury Library list of databases, or contact the library at <a href="mailto:library@sbs.ox.ac.uk">library@sbs.ox.ac.uk</a> to request access.</b>
<b>Fame</b> [BVD]	UK: Contains financial information for companies in the UK and Ireland, including balance sheets, ratios, credit score and price information.
<b>DataStream</b> [Thomson Reuters]	GLOBAL: Contains long runs of global equities data including bonds, commodities, futures and options. As well as economic series.  🔑 <i>Accessible only via Sainsbury Library PCs.</i>
<b>Mergent Online</b> [Mergent]	GLOBAL: Provides financial details of over 25,000 active and inactive global companies. Also includes over 300,000 historical annual reports, filings and executive profiles.
<b>Mergent Archive</b> [Mergent]	GLOBAL: International market and industry reports, company annual reports from 1900 – 1996, and Moody’s corporate manuals from 1909.

<b>Historical Annual Reports</b> [Proquest]	GLOBAL (but predominantly US): The database from <b>ProQuest</b> contains annual reports for over 800 companies from 1844 onwards.
<b>Zephyr</b> [BVD]	GLOBAL: Provides comprehensive deal data including information on M&A, IPO, private equity and venture capital deals.
<b>JOURNAL ARTICLES AND E-BOOKS</b>	
<b>ABI/Inform</b> [Proquest]	Provides access to business and management journals and trade publications. Includes full text of <b>The Economist</b> .
<b>Ebrary</b> [Proquest]	Provides access to 84,000 ebooks from over 500 academic publishers that may be read online or downloaded for a period of 2 weeks. Search interface enables searching within the text.
<b>Business Source Complete</b> [EBSCO]	Provides access to business and management journals and trade publications, including the full-text of <i>Harvard Business Review</i> . Includes full text of the <b>Harvard Business Review</b> .
<b>OECD iLibrary</b> [OECD]	A complete full-text and searchable collection of books and research papers published by the OECD and international statistics.
<b>ABI/Inform – Trade and Industry</b> [Proquest]	Similar to <i>ABI/Inform</i> but with focus on publications and subjects at the trade level.
<b>NEWSPAPERS AND NEWSWIRES</b>	
<b>Factiva</b> [Dow Jones]	GLOBAL: A vast international news database providing daily, up-to-date articles from thousands of newspapers, trade journals and newswires from across the globe.
<b>Nexis UK</b> [LexisNexis]	GLOBAL: Similar to <b>Factiva</b> but also includes websites, and company filings and other registered company and financial reports.
<b>FT.Com</b> [Financial Times]	GLOBAL: The entire content of the <b>Financial Times online</b> .   <b>To register for this service please follow the instructions on the guide on our list of databases page.</b>

## INDUSTRY AND MARKET REPORTS

<b>EMIS</b>	Focuses specifically on 70 emerging markets, including China and the Arab world. As well as reports, it is particularly strong in its coverage of news from local newspapers and publications.
<b>Economist Intelligence Unit</b>	<p>Offers the latest in management thinking and latest global reports for the automotive; consumer goods; energy; financial services; healthcare; and telecoms &amp; technology sectors.</p> <p>Features Harvard Style summaries of current thinking in key management themes, written by leading academics in top business schools throughout the world.</p>
<b>IBIS</b>	Coverage is across all industry groups, but includes both market and industry reports for industries in the UK, China and selected global markets.
<b>Mintel</b>	Like <b>Keynote</b> , provides market relating to the UK and strong for the retail, leisure and industrial industries.
<b>Passport</b>	Reports are compiled from official sources such as the <i>World Bank</i> , the <i>IMF</i> and national statistical bodies to compile reports containing statistics, overviews and comment on industry, country and consumer trends.
<b>Thomson One</b>	<p>This collection is a package of <b>Thomson</b> services, includes three distinct modules: Deals; Private Equity and Research. The Research module provides analyst reports on companies and industries, globally, from over 1,000 investment banks and consulting firms worldwide.</p> <p> <b>Works only with certain versions of Internet Explorer 7, 8 and 9.
