

Major grant award success

A Leverhulme Trust research grant has been awarded to the Bodleian Libraries for the project "Painting by numbers: decoding Ferdinand Bauer's Colour Code". The aim of this project is to reconstruct the artist Bauer's palette and colour chart using the same pigments he would have used in Sibthorp's *Flora Graeca* (published 1806-40), held in the [Sherardian Library of Plant Taxonomy](#).

HEFCE have announced that journal articles and conference proceedings must be deposited in an institutional or subject repository and made Open Access to be eligible for submission to the post-2014 REF.



Spring-clean at the RSL

The RSL is exploiting a narrow window of opportunity to refresh its open-shelf book collection, in an evidence-based project. The aim is to ensure that what can be found there is relevant, recently-published or recently-used. The collection has almost doubled in size in the last seven years and countermeasures have been on hold, with the result that some areas are full to overflowing. This has made the shelves hard to search or browse and accurate replacement challenging. We expect collection usage, paradoxically, to rise, once the dog can again see the rabbit. There are many e-books and e-book collections available to you such as: Over 1,500 online medical and health care textbooks from Oxford University Press, including almost 600 medical titles via [Oxford Medicine Online](http://www.bodleian.ox.ac.uk/hcl/using-the-libraries/oxford-medicine-online).
