


SOME USEFUL OxLIP+ DATABASES FOR ENGLISH STUDIES

CATALOGUES FOR FINDING BOOKS / JOURNALS	FOR FULL-TEXT WORKS AND CRITICISM	FOR FULL-TEXT JOURNAL ARTICLES
<p style="text-align: center;">OLIS</p> <p>Search OLIS to find all items held by Oxford's libraries, including the Bodleian, faculty/departmental libraries and many of the college libraries.</p> <p>You can place Automated Stack Requests (ASR), view your own reader (patron) record, and reserve books you want to borrow.</p> <p>Guides to OLIS are available in any library or online at: http://www.lib.ox.ac.uk/olis/documentation</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">LION - LITERATURE ONLINE</p> <p>Provides access to the full text of over 350,000 works, reference material, journals and over 5,000 literary websites.</p> <p>The full-text databases may be searched at the same time.</p> <p>N.B. Concurrent access is limited so you should log in to OxLIP+ with your Oxford SSO to avoid having to wait for access.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">OXFORD UNIVERSITY E-JOURNALS</p> <p>Oxford University e-Journals is the electronic journals management system that provides access to all the titles subscribed to by Oxford University Library Services.</p>
		<p style="text-align: center;">JSTOR</p> <p>Provides full-text access to the archives of core journals covering Language and Literature, they do not include the most recent volumes of published journals. JSTOR journals can be found via SOLO or Oxford University eJournals.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">BRITISH LIBRARY INTEGRATED CATALOGUE</p> <p>For the major reference and document supply collections in the British Library.</p> <p>Inter-library loans can be arranged through the Bodleian Library.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">THE SHAKESPEARE COLLECTION</p> <p>This database contains the Arden edition of the works of Shakespeare as well as other important reference material.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Project MUSE</p> <p>Offers access to the most recent volumes of over 300 quality journal titles from some 60 scholarly publishers covering literature and criticism, history, the visual and performing arts and cultural studies. MUSE journals can be found via SOLO or Oxford University eJournals.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">COPAC</p> <p>Access to the catalogues of the major university and research libraries in the United Kingdom, including Oxford and the British Library.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">EEBO</p> <p>Contains the page images of over 96,000 titles listed in Pollard and Redgrave's Short Title Catalogue (1475 - 1640), and Wing's Short Title Catalogue (1641 - 1700), of which 25,000 are now fully searchable. There are also links from the bibliographic records on OLIS.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">MODERN LANGUAGES ASSOCIATION BIBLIOGRAPHY (MLA)</p> <p>Indexes articles and other works on literature, language and linguistics from over 4000 journals, from 1926 to the present.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">ESTC - ENGLISH SHORT TITLE CATALOGUE</p> <p>Contains works printed in English from the beginning of printing to the end of the eighteenth century.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">ECCO</p> <p>Provides fully searchable full text access to nearly 180,000 English-language titles and editions published between 1701 and 1800. There are also links from the bibliographic records on OLIS.</p>	<p>Updated ten times a year.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">OED - OXFORD ENGLISH DICTIONARY - 2nd Edition</p> <p>All 26 volumes of the OED are in this database, which can be searched in different ways - e.g. etymology searches by language or illustrative quotation searches by author.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">CAMBRIDGE COMPANIONS ONLINE</p> <p>Provides electronic access to the Cambridge Companions series. Currently includes more than 360 titles covering literature, philosophy, religion, classics, and cultural studies. Fully searchable by author, title, topic or theme.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">ARTS & HUMANITIES CITATION INDEX</p> <p>One of three databases provided by ISI Web of Knowledge, it indexes articles in arts and humanities journals from 1975 to the present. About 2,200 new references are added each week.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">DICTIONARY OF NATIONAL BIOGRAPHY (DNB)</p> <p>A major source of biographical information about the men and women who shaped all aspects of Britain's past. It offers extensive search options, indexes of people, fields of interest, occupations, places and contributors.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">ZETOC</p> <p>Provides access to the British Library's Electronic Table of Contents of around 20,000 journals. Covers 1993 onwards, is updated daily, and offers an email alerting service.</p>
