- ◆ [Digital.Bodleian](#), the Libraries' new digital collections delivery interface, was launched on 8 July with a [lecture by Bruno Racine](#), President of the Bibliothèque nationale de France
- ◆ We are supporting the work of the [Alan Turing Institute](#), the national institute for data science, with [Lucie Burgess chairing a working group](#) on Research Data Management
- ◆ We are delighted to announce the John Fell Fund has awarded two years' funding to the Bodleian's newly established [Centre for Digital Scholarship](#)
- ◆ We hosted an [Introduction to the International Interoperability Framework](#) (IIF) event in the Weston Library, featuring a lecture by Tom Cramer, Chief Technology Strategist at Stanford University Libraries
- ◆ The Digital Manuscripts Toolkit project announced the [four scholarly projects](#) which have been awarded funding to begin working with BDLSS staff from September
- ◆ With Professor Daniel Wakelin, colleagues won Fell funding for the [DIY Digitization](#) project, studying the research impact of readers' own photography in Special Collections reading rooms
- ◆ Over 1,800 researchers have linked their [ORCID and University accounts](#) establishing [unique identifiers](#) for their online presence
- ◆ With IT Services and Research Services, we have set up the [Research Data Management \(RDM\) Delivery Group](#) to join up delivery of services and projects supporting RDM at the University
- ◆ [Act on Acceptance](#), the University's new service to support Open Access, went live on 1 October
- ◆ A new [thesis deposit form](#) for Oxford University Research Archive (ORA) was launched on Wednesday 23 September, following on from the new article and ORA-Data deposit forms
- ◆ With the University's Refugee Studies Centre, Department of International Development, ORA is ingesting current and back issues of '[Forced Migration Review](#)'
- ◆ The [Digital Humanities at Oxford Summer School 2015](#), the most successful yet, hosted over 160 participants and 80 speakers in Oxford this July
- ◆ We have been disseminating our work and engaging with research and library communities in [Oxford, London, Galway, Sydney, Kyoto, Tokyo, and Paris](#)
