



As a result, we don't renew any subscription without a careful review of usage and cost. The following resources are now due for renewal and have low usage with a high cost per download compared to other journal subscriptions:

As a result, we're considering the renewal of these titles and any impact if we were to cancel them. Please note that this isn't a notice of their cancellation, at the moment we're gauging their usage and their value to our research community.

The life and legacy of Dr John Radcliffe - Remembering Radcliffe

The Bodleian Libraries' [winter exhibition](#) celebrates the life and legacy of John Radcliffe, a physician and philanthropist who had uncanny success in diagnosing and treating his patients, and left much of his fortune to charitable causes.

The exhibition considers three buildings which bear his name (the Radcliffe Infirmary, the Radcliffe Observatory and the Radcliffe Camera), and his ongoing legacy in the work of the [Radcliffe Trust](#) as it marks the 300th anniversary of his death.
