Luther Research

Luther studies are both eased and complicated by excellent editions of his writings, aids to their use, and secondary literature so extensive (Leppin; Hendrix, "American Luther Research"; "Martin Luther") that Luther is one of those about whom it is said "more has been written about him than anyone else besides Christ." Since 1956 pentennial meetings of the International Congress for Luther Research have gathered scholars to exchange views. The periodicals Lutherjahrbuch and Archiv für Reformationsgesckichte Literaturbericht provide annual bibliographies. The "Weimar edition" of Luther's works was produced as a model of scholarly editing; a significant amount of his oeuvre appears in English translation. Access to editions of his collected works is guided by Kurt Aland's Hilfsbuch zum Lutherstudium.

Readers of English may begin with James Kittelson's, which has replaced Roland Bainton's introduction to his life.

Mickleham, February 29th, 1793.
