
A unique and limited collectible, signed by Sir John Major

"Labour's Double Whammy"

Created for the 1992 election campaign, this poster helped to win the Conservatives an unprecedented 4th successive general election victory against an unenviable backdrop of a worsening recession and 4 out of 5 polls giving Labour a lead. It is one of the most memorable post-War political images and helped to turn an expected defeat into victory. It also helped John Major achieve the most votes received by any political party in a British general election, polling over 14 million votes.



Saatchi & Saatchi's 1992 poster is credited with bringing the phrase 'Double Whammy' into widespread use in the UK. Reputedly the brainchild of Chris Patten, then Conservative Party Chairman, this catchy and hard-hitting message successfully undermined Labour's efforts to rid itself of its image as a high tax-and-spend Party, forcing it onto the defensive in what had been a highly-successful election campaign, and helped to win the election for the Conservatives.

Neil Kinnock had made great strides to present Labour as a more centrist force, including dropping the long-standing commitment to unilateral nuclear disarmament and re-nationalisation of privatised industry. And with John Smith as Shadow Chancellor, all manifesto policy proposals had been carefully costed out. But on 6th January, 1992 "Labour's Double Whammy" was launched alongside the "Labour's Tax Bombshell". The two posters, together with press advertisements and daily press conferences helped to emphasise the message that voting Labour meant more taxes and higher prices, with the claim that Labour's plans would mean tax increases of more than £1,000 a year for the average voter. This was reinforced by the 'Labour's Tax Bombshell' party election broadcast which costed Labour's spending plans at £35 billion.

The success of the campaign distracted Labour into bringing out a 'shadow budget' on 17th March 1992 just a week after Norman Lamont's actual budget and in the first week of the election campaign, in a show of openness which failed to undo the damage.
