There are currently problems with shelfmark searches for Chinese language materials. For better results use the new "in the shelfmark (Chinese records)" limit and change full-stops and slashes to a space. For example, to find "Chin.e.6817/5" search for "Chin e 6817 5".

Electronic Legal Deposit Restrictions

The Legal Deposit Act 2003 imposes restrictions on electronic items received under Legal Deposit:

- Items may **ONLY** be read on Library owned computers within the Bodleian Libraries
- Saving, copying and pasting is forbidden
- But **PRINTING** is allowed using the PCAS system
- Each item may only be viewed by one person at a time



Reading List Tips

- What you need to look up on SOLO should be indicated somehow
- Italics or underlining, etc.
(*Antipode*, Global geomorphology)
- Remember that explanatory text could be inserted between the elements of the reference.



Book?, Chapter?, Article? - TIPS

- Books – Year only
- Chapters – Use the word “IN”
- Articles- Many more numbers for volume, part (or issue), pages.



Tutors are not infallible !

Errors will (& do) creep in:

BEWARE: Misspellings & typos

e.g. Pomerantz(2009) *Theory, Culture & Society*
26 July-August, 9-10, 32-51.

Correct: Pomeranz (2009) *Theory, Culture & Society* 26, 7-8, 32-51.

- Avoid trouble by getting into good habits now – always record your source, and the date you found it
- Learn to cite references in a standard way – e.g. the Harvard system

Plagiarism is presenting someone else's work or ideas as your own, with or without their consent, by incorporating it into your work without full acknowledgement. All published and unpublished material, whether in manuscript, printed or electronic form, is covered under this definition. Plagiarism may be intentional or reckless, or unintentional. Under the regulations for examinations, intentional or reckless plagiarism is a disciplinary offence.

Collusion is another form of plagiarism involving the unauthorised collaboration of students (or others) in a piece of work.

Cases of suspected plagiarism in assessed work are investigated under the disciplinary regulations concerning conduct in examinations. Intentional or reckless plagiarism may incur severe penalties, including failure of your degree or expulsion from the university.

We ask **all** students to read the University's [guidance on plagiarism](#).

Disciplinary regulations

In their Memorandum, [The Student Handbook](#), the Proctors and Assessor draw attention to the disciplinary regulations relating to plagiarism that must be observed by both undergraduate and graduate students:

Section 9.6

3. *No candidate shall cheat or act dishonestly, or attempt to do so, in any way, whether before, during or after an examination, so as to obtain or seek to obtain an unfair advantage in an examination.*
4. *No candidate shall present for an examination as his or her own work any part or the substance of any part of another person's work.*
5. *In any written work (whether thesis, dissertation, essay, coursework, or written examinations) passages quoted or closely paraphrased from another person's work must be identified as quotations or paraphrases, and the source of the quoted or paraphrased material must be clearly acknowledged.*
6. *Unless specifically permitted by the special Subject Regulations for the examination concerned, no candidate shall submit to the examiners any work which he or she has previously submitted partially or in full for examination at this University or elsewhere. Where earlier work by the candidate is citable, he or she shall reference it clearly.*
7. *No person shall dishonestly give help to a candidate before, during or after an examination so as to give, or attempt to give, that candidate an unfair advantage in an examination.*



Guide: Journal Articles

For structured literature searching you should begin with **SCOPUS** (which includes Geobase). SCOPUS is the world's largest abstract and citation database of peer-reviewed literature and quality web sources, offering tools to track, analyze and visualize research, with links to the full-text. There are also various discipline-specific resources such as **EconLit** for searching the economics literature. For more such specific databases see the Left Hand Panel.

SOLO has a new tab for searching for journal articles (in beta stage), which will search Primo Central - a cross-disciplinary resource comprising citations to about 400 million articles, many of which are available in full-text to Oxford scholars. Although comprehensive, you should be warned that Primo Central is not exhaustive at this time, and that you should consult specialist databases or seek help from a librarian to ensure, when needed, highly accurate searching in particular subject areas. The pull-down menu next to the Journal Articles search box allows you to choose a subject category to cross-search a set of selected databases. 10 Search Tips

1. Ask a clear research question. Break the question down in to keywords.
2. For each keyword, consider relevant search terms (synonyms, alternative spellings, broader/narrower terms, etc.)
3. Apply truncation, usually * to find plurals/alternative word endings and ? to replace a single character.
4. Quote marks are often used to specify a phrase.
5. Consider the relationships between your search terms using **Boolean logic**: use **AND** to narrow your search (records must contain both search terms); **OR** to broaden your search (records can contain either search term); and **NOT** to exclude from your search (records must not include a particular term).
6. Search strings may be joined using parentheses or run as separate search sets and combined at the end.
7. Consider whether filters should be applied to your search e.g.

Modern **geomorphology** was founded in the nineteenth century as an exercise of historical interpretation of landscapes. After the mid-twentieth century it dominantly became a quest to understand the processes by which landscapes are modified. This focused attention on the measurement of sediment fluxes on synoptic timescales and on a reductionist, Newtonian programme of construction of low-order theories about those fluxes, largely imported from engineering science. The period also saw the emergence of an applied **geomorphology**. Toward the end of the twentieth century the subject was dramatically transformed by improved technologies for remote sensing and surveying of Earth's surface, the advent of personal computation and of large-scale computation, and important developments of absolute dating techniques. These technical innovations in turn promoted recognition of **geomorphology** as a 'system science' and facilitated the reintegration of tectonics into **geomorphology**, opening the way for a renewed consideration of the **history** of the landscape. Finally, increasing recognition of the dominance of human agency in contemporary modification of Earth's terrestrial surface has become a significant theme.
