### RemotePrint



To celebrate the 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the New England Journal of Medicine we have purchased access to the backfile (1812 – 1989) as a complement to our current subscription. Very few UK Universities provided access to this resource, which is now listed in [SOLO](#) and [OU E-Journals](#).

Interesting fact: The New England Journal of Medicine was known as two separate journals until 1928 - The Boston Medical Intelligencer, and the Boston Medical and Surgical Journal. These titles are included in the backfile.
