Following a successful trial in Trinity Term, 2013, all University staff and students now have access to over 84,000 extra e-books in the [Ebrary Academic Complete](#) collection.

The books come from 500 prestigious academic publishers and range across all disciplines. The books are all displayed and searchable on [SOLO](#) and include 14-day downloads to mobile devices. The package will be updated regularly, includes almost 7,000 textbooks in its "Medicine" collection and is also available directly at <http://site.ebrary.com/lib/bodleian/home.action>
