

(<http://casereports.bmj.com/>) is the largest single collection of case reports online with more than 8,500 peer-reviewed articles from over 70 countries. It offers a high volume of cases in all disciplines so that healthcare professionals and researchers can easily find information on common and rare conditions. Articles are indexed in **PubMed**. As a member of the University or the OUH Trust you have full-text access to all the case reports. You can also submit your own free of charge - please contact us to obtain the appropriate Fellowship code.

Marks of Genius Exhibition, Weston Library

The Weston Library, the “newest” Bodleian Library, has recently opened, including the first exhibition in its new galleries **Marks of Genius: masterpieces from the collections of the Bodleian Libraries**. In over four centuries the Bodleian Libraries have assembled, through gift and purchase, many individual items which can be called works of genius. This exhibition looks at ways in which common attitudes towards genius are manifested in the physical form of a number of remarkable books and manuscripts, and considering the relationship between genius and learning, it explores ways in which the works of genius found in a university library can be acquired, collected and read.

The exhibition features world-renowned items of the Bodleian's unique collections, including many scientific and medical works.

The exhibition runs from 21st March to 20th September 2015, Monday-Saturday: 10am-5pm, Sunday: 11am-5pm and admission is free.
