Compliance with Wellcome Trust Open Access policy

Congratulations to Oxford authors on their high rate of compliance with the Wellcome Trust Open Access policy. A snapshot report showed a rise from 88% to 91.4% between December 2013 and August 2015, considerably higher than the national rate of 75%.

## Changes to PCAS
