

Database Trial - EarthDoc

We currently have a trial to a new Earth Sciences database. EarthDoc is EAGE's online geoscience database which contains more than 62,000 event papers and journal articles. EarthDoc gives you the opportunity to consult many years of research and a vast expanse of technical knowledge. Articles cover Geology, Geophysics, Near Surface, Petroleum engineering, Reservoir and Production Engineering. The trial will run until Thurs 15th February. It will be available via OxLIP+ at



I wish to borrow a new standard loan item from the Bodleian Health Care Libraries for the length of elective – what do I do?

Take the item to a member of Bodleian Health Care Staff who can then issue it to you for the length of your placement. The self-issue machine will only issue the item for the standard loan length. Finally please note, in order to avoid any fines that may occur if we are unable to renew items you currently have on loan, we advise students to do this BEFORE you leave Oxford.
