- **Charity Open Access Fund block grant 2017-18 now available**
The COAF block grant for the new year is now operational. Authors no longer have to claim Open Access fees from their individual funders. - **Celebrating ten years of ORA** (Oxford University Research Archive)
The University's institutional repository ORA is 10 years old, and a cornerstone of open access at Oxford. It recently hit some milestones:
 - Over 1 million visits to ORA site.
 - Over 200,000 records in ORA.
 - Over 27,000 full text items currently available for download.
 - Over 21,000 full text deposits made between October 2015 and October 2017.
 - Downloads up by 55% over the past year.An infographic to mark ORA's first decade, plus a poster tracing its history, can be viewed on the ORA LibGuide (<http://libguides.bodleian.ox.ac.uk/ora>).

- **Are you aware of new policy for RCUK Open Access Block Grant?**
RCUK-funded researchers are reminded that Oxford's policy for our RCUK block grant changed in August and means we are no longer able to pay Article Processing Charges for hybrid (subscription-based) journals. Authors of these articles should use the 'Green' route to open access, regardless of journal embargo length. For fully open access journals (listed in doaj.org) authors can apply for APC costs while RCUK funds are still available; please check with the APC team first.
