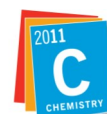

Duke Humfrey's Night 2011

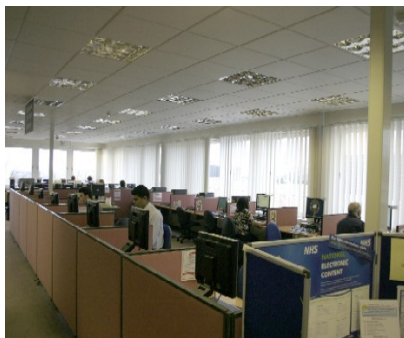

Major new e-books for Medical Students

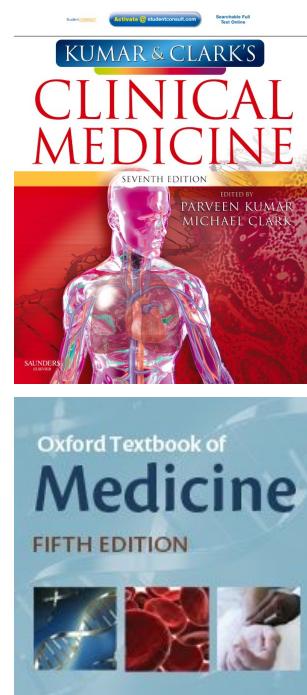
We are delighted to announce that, due to generous funding from the **Nuffield Oxford Hospitals Fund (NOHF)**, we have secured 3-year access to the following major online textbooks:

- *Kumar and Clark's Clinical Medicine*
- *Davidson's Principles and Practice of Medicine*
- *Macleod's Clinical Examination*
- *Illustrated Textbook of Paediatrics (Lissauer & Clayden)*
- *Oxford Textbook of Medicine*
- *Oxford Handbook of Practical Drug Therapy*
- *Oxford Handbook of Emergency Medicine*
- *Oxford Handbook of Medical Sciences*

These complement our existing collection of 12 Oxford Handbooks (also funded by NOHF) which includes the *Oxford Handbook of Clinical Medicine*.

We have already bought more than 40 key text books via the [EBL interface](#). These are very popular; Bailey & Love's *Short Practice of Surgery* is now the most heavily used title on this inter-disciplinary platform!
