Bell

There is a wooden tallboy with an excellent run of Bell, both roman and italic, which is used and is to be kept. This one of the main house faces. Presented by the Monotype Corporation through Beatrice Warde.

Caslon

There is an excellent collection of Caslon italic and roman in various sizes from 12 to 48 pt. There are 8 pairs of cases in 14 pt that are the main face used for teaching. This is one of the house faces.

Old English

There is a good range of Old English (blackletter) from 12 pt upwards and this is to be kept. It is used regularly.
