Deposit your research in ORA – it’s very easy
When you complete an article, report, conference paper or poster, or other research output, drop a copy in ORA.

EITHER

1. Go to ORA at <http://ora.ouls.ox.ac.uk/> Click on ‘Contribute’ (top right hand corner) and follow the instructions. You’ll need your Oxford SSO (single sign-on) username and password. Enter information about the work: you need only complete the handful of yellow required boxes – we’ll do the rest. Attach the file(s) like you would an email attachment.

Nia's wide range of activities include developing and delivering teaching sessions for the Division's taught M.Sc. courses in Evidence Based Health Care and Global Health and working closely with researchers in the Department of Primary Health Care in direct support of research activity such as horizon scanning for MaDOx (Monitoring & Diagnosis in Oxford). In recognition of this work Nia has been made an Honorary Senior Research Fellow at the Centre for Evidence Based Medicine.
