Security for Laptops in the Bodleian Social Science Library

Please ensure your laptop is secure at all times; do not leave your laptop unattended unless you have secured it to a desk. Laptop locks can be looped through the desks and laptop anchor points have been provided on desks where this isn't possible. Locks are available to borrow from the issue desk.

Lockers are situated in the room behind the main building reception desk if you wish to store your laptop during lunch etc. Padlocks for the lockers can be borrowed from the library issue desk.

Bodleian Libraries

- for all registered users of the Bodleian Libraries
- can only be used on one device at a time
- log in each time you use it

Connecting to this network

- 1 Connect your laptop or mobile device to the Bodleian-Libraries network.
- 2 Open a web browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Firefox).
- 3 You will be prompted for your barcode number (shown on your Library or University card) and your password.
- 4 Each time you visit the Libraries you will need to log in to the network.

Which password do I use?

Library Cards and University Cards are issued with a default password of your date of birth in the format DDMMYYYY (e.g. 16OCT1988). You should reset your password to something more secure as soon as possible at <https://register.bodleian.ox.ac.uk>. If you have forgotten your Library or University Card password, and need help to reset it, please ask a member of Library staff. eduroam

- for all Oxford University students and staff
- for members of other academic institutions who have already set up their home eduroam account
- don't need to log in each time you use it

Connecting to this network (Oxford Users)

Key general points are:

- network is eduroam in lower case
- username and password come from your Remote Access account.
Note: This is not your Oxford SSO
- domain is ox.ac.uk

Connecting to this network (non-Oxford Users)

Members of other academic institutions need to have already set up their home eduroam account to use the network in Oxford. If you have problems using your account, please contact your home institution's IT support service.



OWL

- for all Oxford University students and staff
- don't need to log in each time you use it

Connecting to this network

This service makes use of the Remote Access accounts and Cisco VPN service that IT Services offers to all University members. To use OWL you need:

- a valid and active IT Services Remote Access account
- Cisco VPN Client installed and configured on your system. There are instructions about how to do this on the IT Services website
- newer devices may have a VPN client already installed (the configuration instructions on the IT Services website show you how to find out if yours does)
