

## Open Access: What you need to know

HEFCE policy for the next REF requires 'author accepted manuscripts' (final peer-reviewed version) to be deposited in an institutional or subject repository within three months of acceptance for

publication and made open access within

12 months. This condition must be met from 1st April 2016 for all journal articles and conference proceedings with an ISSN. **Outputs will only be eligible for submission in the next REF if**

**HEFCE's OA conditions are met.** The policy applies whether the underlying research was externally funded or not.

Non-compliance will render outputs ineligible for the REF. Non-compliance at the time of paper acceptance cannot be made to be compliant later.

### Oxford's response and implementation plans

To ensure the University is able to meet HEFCE's OA requirements a [pilot project](#) is taking place during Hilary Term 2015. The pilot includes two departments from the Medical Sciences Division: NDM (Experimental Medicine) and Biochemistry.
