


Preparing for life after Oxford – NHS online resources for new FT1s.

If you're starting work in the NHS this summer and want access to online databases, ebooks and full text online journals then you need to know about NHS OpenAthens, the username and password system used by the NHS to provide access to online resources. Access is available from anywhere with an Internet connection.

Nationally-available resources include bibliographic databases such as *Medline* and *Embase*, as well as hundreds of online textbooks and journals and your OpenAthens account will also give you access to resources purchased by your local Trust library service.

You can register for OpenAthens at <https://openathens.nice.org.uk> as soon as you're in post in the NHS. If you register from a PC on the NHS network or with an NHS email address, your account will be created automatically and immediately.
