Mobile Induction Project

The Bodleian Libraries recently successfully bid for [JISC](#) funding to develop a new undergraduate library induction which students will be able to access **on the move, 24/7** through smartphones and tablet computers (although it will also work on desktop and laptop computers). Consultation with students has shown that the libraries at Oxford can be daunting for Freshers. This new electronic supplement to existing physical tours and inductions will provide instant, clear assistance for tasks such as:

- locating items on reading lists
- using photocopyers
- retrieving key information about libraries (such as location and opening times)

The project is being led by [Angela Carritt](#) (User Education Co-ordinator) and [Ollie Bridle](#) (Biochemistry Subject Librarian). 
