The Bodleian and College Libraries have been working over the past year on a [JISC](http://www.jisc.ac.uk)-funded project to develop an online library induction designed primarily for delivery via Smartphones and other mobile devices. The result of this project, **Library Assistant**, is now live at <http://www.bodleian.ox.ac.uk/assistant> in time for use by 2013 freshers at the start of Michaelmas. It can also be accessed by scanning the QR code below.



Library Assistant is designed to run alongside traditional face to face inductions. It is intended to help new students discover which libraries are most relevant to their course, find items on reading lists, access their library account and library wifi networks, and use printing and photocopying services. Although it is primarily intended for use on mobiles and tablets, it can also be used on desktop and laptop computers.

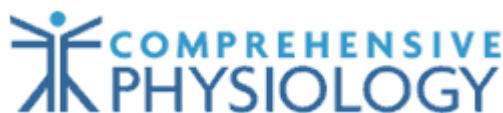
