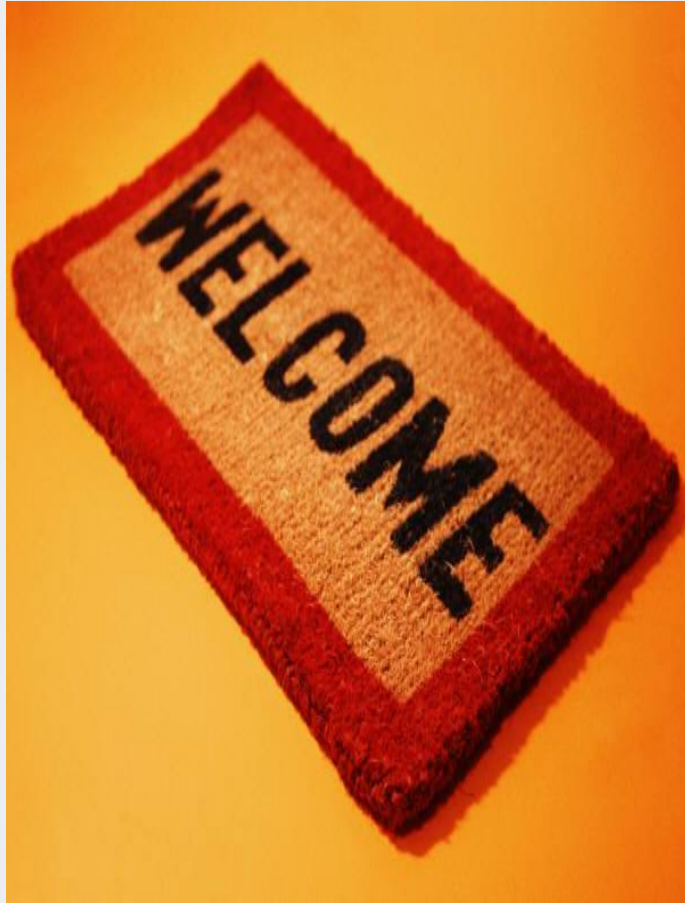

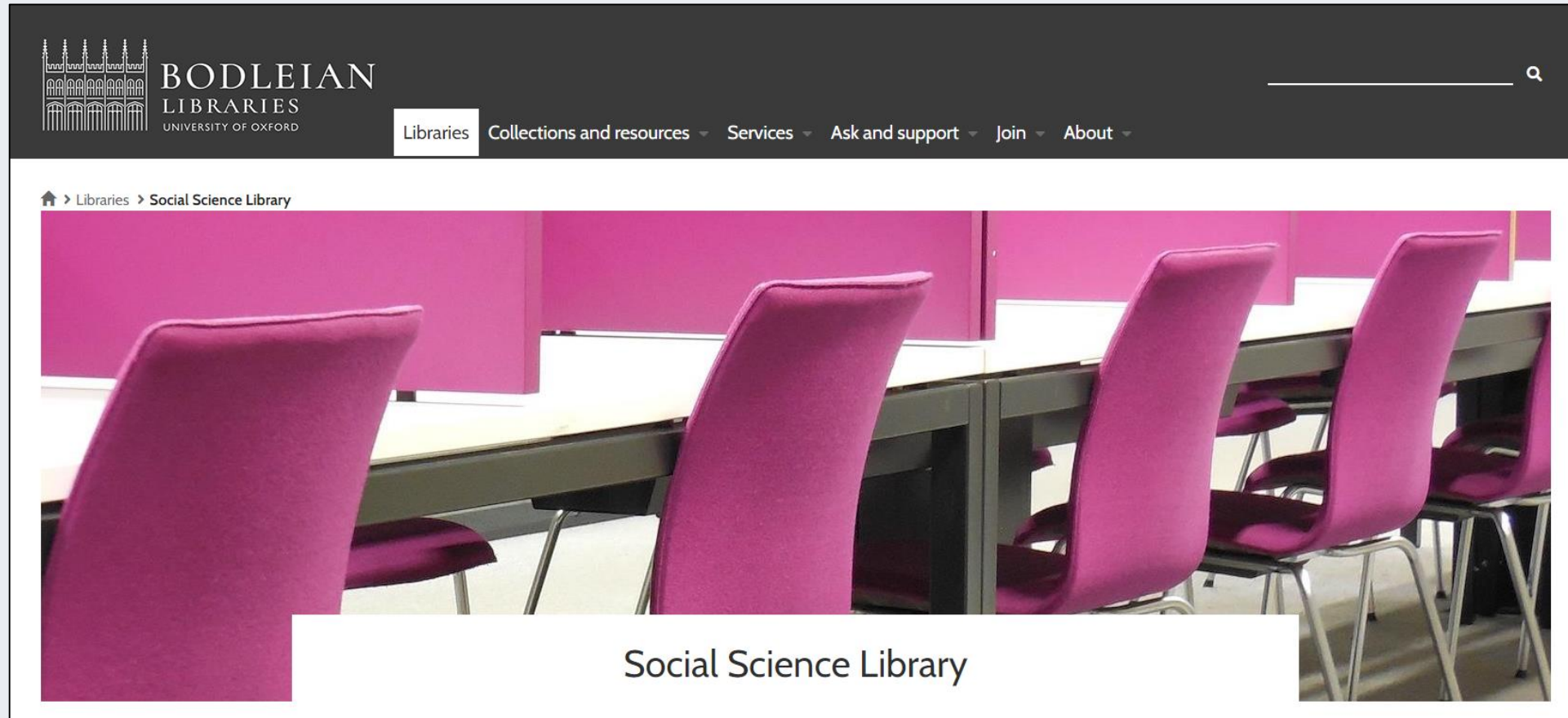

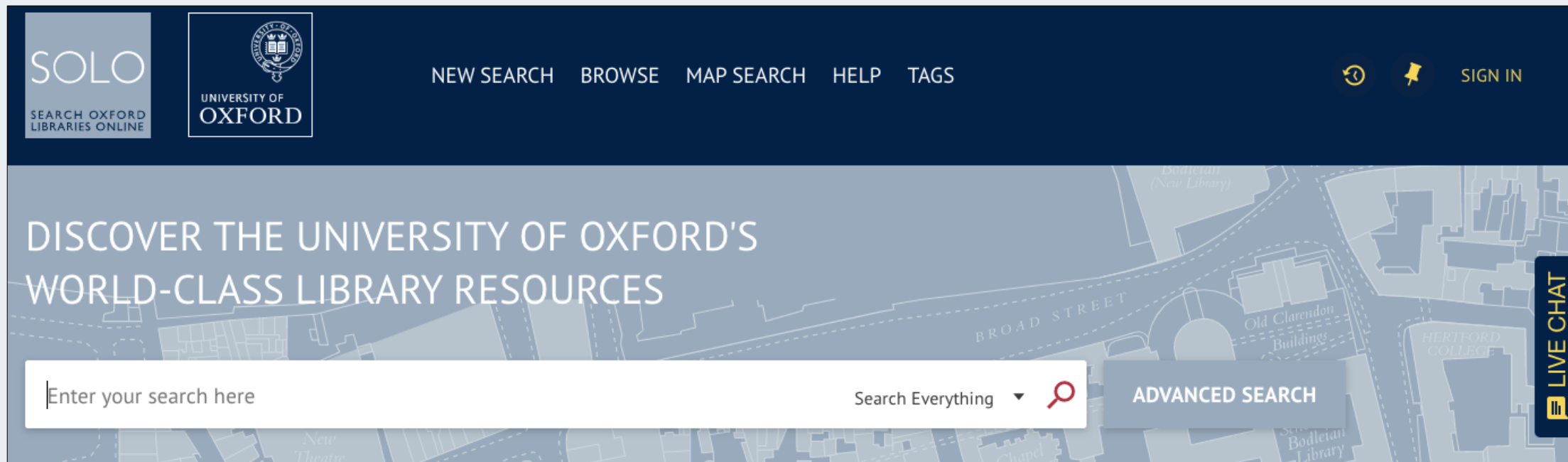

Failure to comply may result in:


- Referral to the University Proctors
