



Printing, Copying, Scanning - PCAS



- Account set up automatically
- ➤ Use Bodleian Libraries username/password
- > On first use link university card to account
- Top up using credit/debit card at https://pcas.bodleian.ox.ac.uk (or select icon on library PCs)
- Remember scanning is FREE!














SOLO - Placing requests for books when all on loan





Summary: getting hold of the book you need Item in place Look for copies in your subject library and Loanable - 28 Days college library which show both 'Item in place' and 'Loanable' 2. If there are none, click 'Request' and look for a "Borrow From" option in the list of delivery Borrow From: locations 3. If there are no In Place items and no Borrow From options, then it is likely the only copy Read At: available to you is a copy from offsite storage
