





SOLO – Search for a title (3)




Enter keywords in the search bar and hit the search icon






SOLO – Search results (4)



In the results screen, SOLO clusters print and online copies of the same title




SOLO – Print books (5)



Click Find & Request to see which libraries have a copy of the book




SOLO – Filter results (6)



If you get too many results, you can sort and filter in the pane on the left




SOLO - Placing requests for books when all on loan (7)






SOLO – Placing an Offsite request (8)

















The final book format in the results list is electronic Legal Deposit




