Wildcards and Phrases

Wildcard symbols for word variants:

Truncation:

control* for controls, controller, controlling...

British and American spelling:

characteri?ation

Phrases:


"position control*"

Boolean commands

• AND - includes

• **OR** – broadens out

• **NOT** – excludes



Boolean operators

OR: synonyms and keywords for the same concept:

"Position control*" **OR** "path tracking"

AND: different concepts:

"Position control*" **OR** "path tracking"

AND

("Autonomous vehicle*" **OR** "Mobile robots")





ORA – Oxford University Research Archive



CORE (COnecting REpositories) - open access content from the UK and worldwide repositories

BASE (Bielefeld Academic Search Engine) - 60% of the indexed documents are accessible for free

OSF Preprints: - all subjects




